Golden Path's application Compass helps:

Schools

- Store 4-year rolling plans
- Connect with employers
- Manage Work-based Learning
- Facilitate student career exploration with admin tools
- Learn real-time what education employers need in future workforce

• Students:

- Learn about their skills based on their experiences
- Connect with employers for immediate experiences and future opportunities
- Get sponsorships to help pay for school or help finding a job

Employers


- Connect with schools and students at scale

Getting to Compass for Students

- Students access Compass through RUReady.ND.gov
- Student updates their profile throughout high school, starting in 8th grade
- A school's course list is loaded into Compass so students see your school's classes






The Student Compass Profile








- Students update Classes, Activities, Hobbies, and Personality
- They update throughout school, once/semester
- Under "Results" students see Holland Codes and can view opportunities
- Opportunities include:
 - Career Profiles
 - Employers
 - Link to generic careers
 - Link to Work-based Learning
 - Events
- You can see what students enter in the Compass Console




- Students add classes they've taken or going to take
- Students add additional information if needed
- Same process for Activities, Hobbies, and Personality
- Plan can be modified as student progresses through high school
- Students can print out plan
- Can be shared with parents, reviewed with school professionals through RUReady

In addition to storing the 4-year rolling plan, Compass uses that information to provide information on:


- Holland Codes

The Employer Database

- Information comes from employers themselves
- You can search by headquarters location, offering type, career cluster
- You can see additional information for contact information, company overviews
- For opportunities (WBL, Career Profiles, Events) you will receive email notifications




Work-based Learning - High Level Workflow

Work-Based Learning Opportunities Created

- Includes Connections DB, WBL, & Career Profiles
- Employers create in Compass, sent to Pro User
- Pro User can also create just for their school
- Once approved, opportunities are visible for students

Students apply to & participate in WBL opportunities

- Students apply, Pro User approves
- Applications shared with employer for approval
- Upon acceptance, a WBL Experience is created, hours logged
- Pro User can initiative evaluations during or at end



Students Learn About Skills & Opportunities


- Students update Compass with classes, activities, hobbies
- Students browse and are matched with opportunities
- Can learn more about companies, careers, and WBL


WBL Completed

The Compass Console

- The Compass Console gives school professionals ability to track & approve student's profiles
- Features include:
 - See completion percentage of all students
 - Look at each student's profile
 - Filter on students by graduation year, high school or middle school
 - See personality assessments, Holland Code results
 - Track employer interest, work-based learning matches, etc.






Modifying the Course List

- You as an administrator can manage your school's course list, including:
 - Adding new classes
 - Renaming classes
 - Deactivating or activating classes
 - Adding credits
- Access through the Compass Console (In Professional Center, go to Work-based Learning, Compass Console)
- Initial Course List will be pre-populated using a PowerSchool export
- School courses are all mapped to the Master State Course List using MIS03 Codes



Compass on Mobile for Students

- Student can update profile, browse opportunities, sign up for notifications.
- Notifications sent for new opportunities, matches, etc. Student chooses rhythm.
- Requires student to first be logged into RUReady.nd.gov to get a mobile code





- Share information about your company and specific careers with thousands of students
- Students learn about your company, your positions, and any sponsorships.
- Can be done by employer or through GPS interview process
- Links provided to profile and any other promotional material (URLs, videos)
- Fees apply based on how it's built and how broadly it's shared

Quick Review of the 4-Year Rolling Plan

- The 4-year rolling plan is a requirement for Choice Ready and needed for every student
- It should be reviewed twice/year with a student from 8th grade through 12th grade
- Includes:
 - Classes a student is planning to take through school
 - Activities they may want to try
 - High level overview of student's plans after graduation
- Choice Ready requires the last date the plan was reviewed with the student
- No specific format needed to capture, so every school does different
 - Spreadsheets
 - PDF
 - RUReady Course of Study
 - Compass
