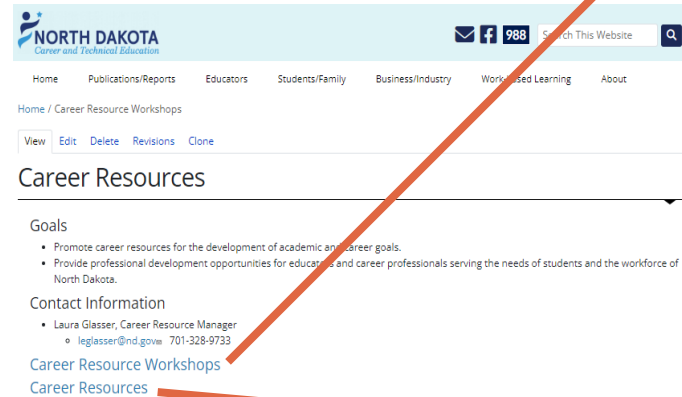

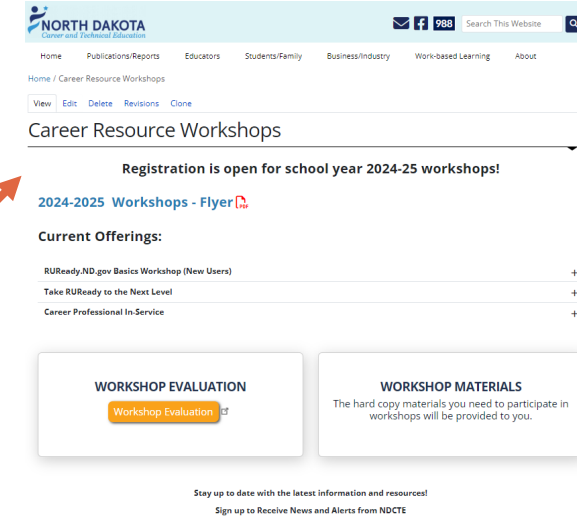
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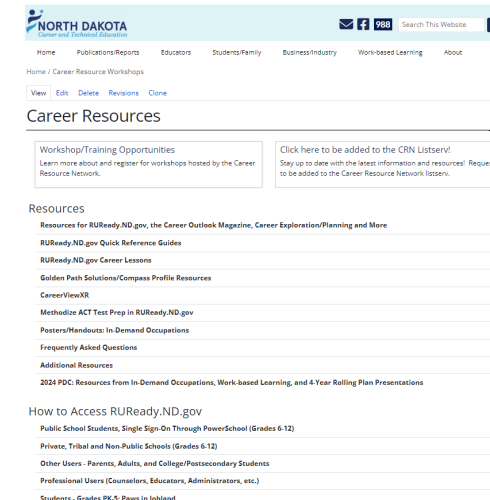

Application for Admission

Welcome to your practice application!

Many colleges use the introduction page of their application to give you information on program or college admission requirements. Take the time to read their first page carefully before you begin filling out the application.

Most college applications require you to provide the following types of information.

- Your name and address
- Personal information such as gender, citizenship, ethnicity (some of these fields will be optional)
- Enrollment information including whether you're applying as a freshman or transfer student and your intended major
- Educational information such as the high school you attended and your test scores
- Activities and interests including work and volunteer experiences
- Parent information

Before you begin filling out the application on the next few screens, take the time to look through what's required and gather any materials you may need (such as records of your volunteer experiences).

Google Docs, Google Sheets, and Google Slides will all be allowed to be selected by the student. Docs will convert to a .docx; sheets to a .xlsx, and slides to a .pptx (Word Doc, Excel Spreadsheet, and PowerPoint Presentation respectively).

Where do these numbers come from?

National Employment and Outlook

Outlook **stable**
The employment change from 2022 to 2032 is estimated to be +3%. (The National average for all occupations is +3%)

Job Openings **very small number**
Less than 1000 average annual openings are expected for this occupation between 2022 and 2032. (The National Average for all occupations is 1,670 openings)

Employment **small occupation**
This was a small occupation in the United States, employing 21,400 workers in 2022. (The National average for all occupations is 147,916 workers)

Growth **Average growth**
The need for petroleum engineers to help facilitate oil and gas extraction at existing operations is expected to create some demand for these workers. However, increased use of renewable energy and weaker investments in fossil fuel production may limit job growth over the projections decade.

Significance of This Upgrade

This upgrade is particularly beneficial when students are involved in work-based learning (WBL) through a CTE Center. Instead of professionals at the CTE Centers managing WBL experiences across multiple school sites, they will be able to manage their students' experiences through their CTE Center's RUPReady.ND.gov Professional Center.
