

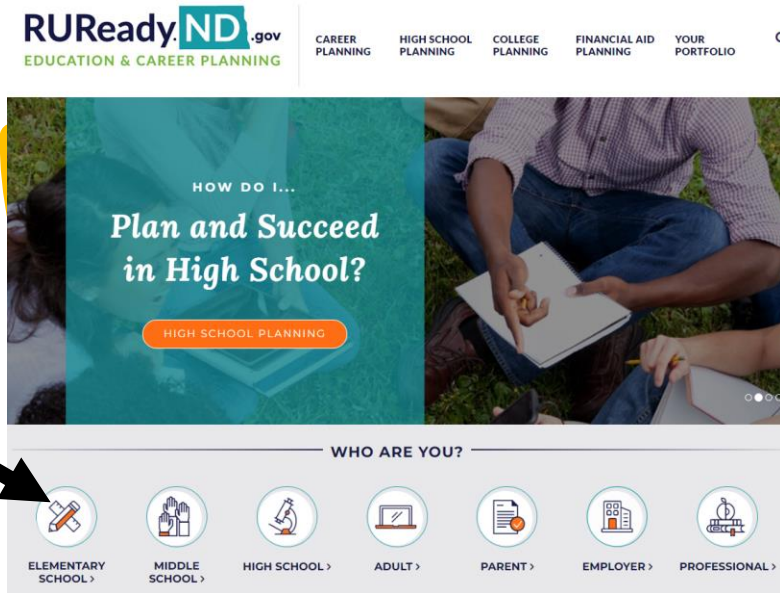

Who has access to RUReady?



- RUReady.ND.gov is the career information platform provided to all students in North Dakota.
- For students in grades PK-5, that starts with Paws in Jobland.
 - Paws in Jobland is easily accessed directly from the RUReady.ND.gov website. No accounts are needed and it can be used by students individually or as a classroom activity.
 - Lesson plans and resources for Paws in Jobland are available.

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- **When students reach the 6th grade, they can have an RUPReady.ND.gov account.**
 - **Why grade 6? To comply with Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) which restricts the collection of data and personal information from kids under the age of 13.**
 - **How are the accounts created/accessed?**
 - **Public school students in grades 6-12**
 - **Accounts are automatically created based on the STARS data schools are reporting to the Department of Public Instruction.**
 - **Private, tribal, and homeschool students create their own accounts.**
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- ND Career and Technical Education's contract provides for every individual age 13 and up to have an RUReady.ND.gov account:
 - Postsecondary students
 - Homeschool students
 - Adults/Parents
 - What's the difference? A parent account will show what RUReady looks like from the student perspective. Student's can give permission to their parent to connect to their account and see information they've saved to their portfolio.
 - Vocational Rehabilitation and Job Service have Professional Center Access to their client's accounts. That's a separate contract that they have with XAP Corporation.

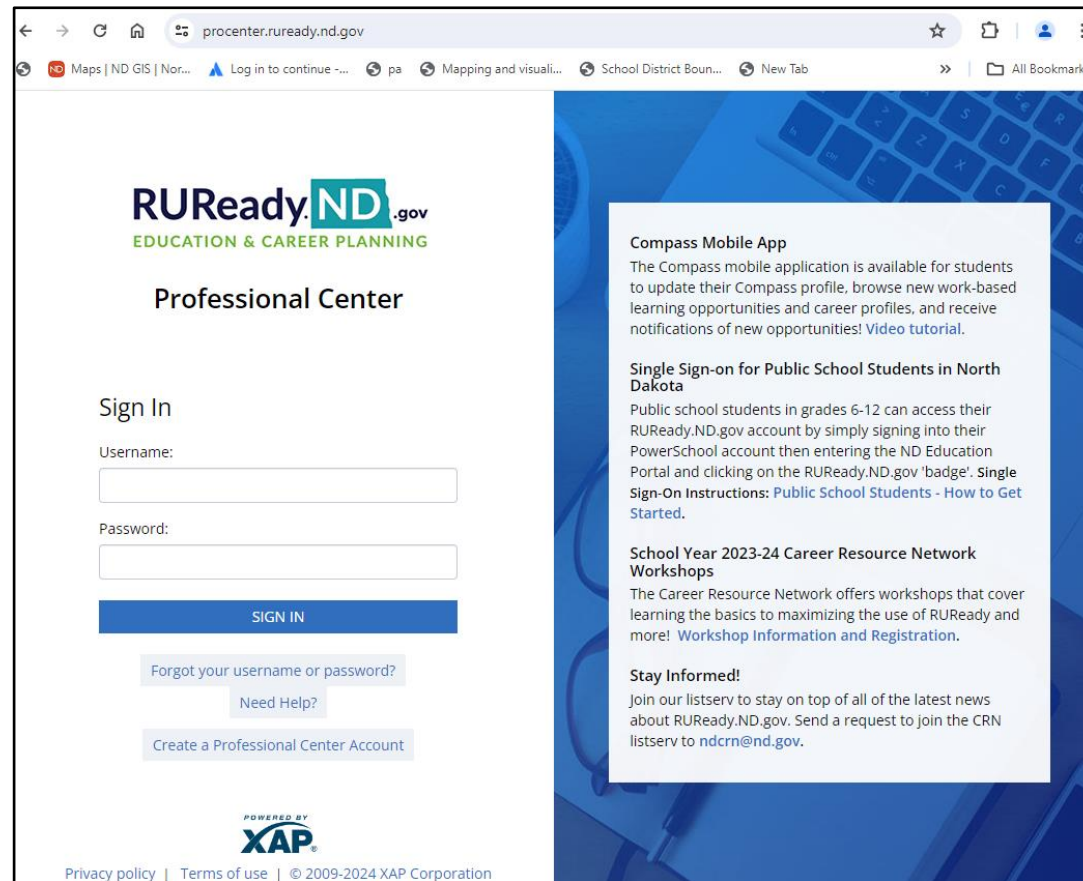

Each of you has an RUReady.ND.gov Professional Center Account. This account will allow you to track student progress, assign activities, run reports, access the Work-based Learning module, and more!

The “Demo Account” allows you to view RUReady from the student perspective. You do not need a separate account.

Keep in mind that the Demo Account opens in a pop-up window! If nothing happens when you click on Demo Account, check for a pop-up blocker notification.
